

VMEA Notes Submission Requirements

Submissions for publication in VMEA Notes may cover any area of music education at any instructional level. Submissions must:

- Be concise and well-structured. Spelling and grammar should be perfect. Articles should not exceed 1,000 words in length. Articles submitted for consideration should be sent by email in Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx format) and may be accompanied by properly licensed photos or graphics in .pdf, .jpeg, or .tiff format.
- Manuscripts containing footnotes and/or quotations must contain a full bibliographic reference for verification by the editor (including author(s), title or volume number, issue number, publisher, date, page(s)). References to footnotes, musical examples, diagrams, etc., should appear on an attached end page with numerical references corresponding to your written text. For appropriate format, consult the APA style manual for guidelines on writing an article.
- Please avoid the use of copyrighted works of art, photos, clip art, drawings, diagrams, etc. You may submit original artwork, original photos, or public domain clip art/graphics with your manuscript.
